- d) To train, guide and assist the people of the area of operation in democratic organisation, democratic functioning and social action on the one hand and adoption of modern technologies and scientific methods on the other for the achievement of objects (a( & (b) .
- e) To develop the leadership potential of the people and specially the youth, by making them responsible for specific group tasks, by intensive training and by imparting to them the necessary experties to accomplish them satisfactorily.
- f) To organise the people for and guide and help them in eradication of poverty, inaction, hunger, inquities, social evils on the basis of mutual help, collective endeavour and cooperative enterprise.

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## THE WEST BENGAL SOCIETIES REGISTRATION ACT. 1961. REGULATIONS OF ASSOCIATION

### OF SOCIETY.

#### MEMBERSHIP

- Qualification and admission :- The following persons are eligible for membership of the Society:
- a) Any person who has attaind the age of 18 years and who agrees in writing to be bond by the Memorandum and Regulations of the society.
- b) Any society or instituation, whose objects are similar to those of society will be represented by the secretary or any incorporated company or limited company to be represented by one of its directors.
- Class of members : (a) Patrons,
  - (b) Life members,
  - (c) Ordinary "embers,
  - (d) Honorary members.
  - a) The Managing Committee may invite any distinguished person to become a patron of the Society.
  - b) Live Members :- Any persons Institution, Society or Incorporated company, qualified to be member, by paying or having apaid a sum of ks.500/-endoing movable or immovable property of the value of %.500/-or over shall be elected a life member of the society by the Governing Body.
  - c) Ordinary Members :- Any person, Institutions, society or incorporated company, qualified to be member, paying ordinary member of the society and month-subscription at Ns. 0.25/-.
  - d) Honary members := Any person, qualified to be member, whose connection with the society is deemed to be necessary by the Founder members may with the consent of such person be electe an Rohorary member of the Governing Body nor shall be entitled to vote at any meeting.
- Cessation of membership :- Any member shall cease to be a member (a) On his resignation from membership by a letter address to the secretary, (b) On his becoming insane or involvent, (c))n his conviction any offence in connection with formation, promotion, or conduct offairs of a society or a body corporate or any offence involving moral turpitude.
- 4. Register of Member :- The society shall maintain a Register of members containing the names, address and their occupation, the date of cessation. The register will be kept oper for inspection of the members of society on requisition.
- 5. Rights and obligations of members: (a) Any member of the society has the right to elect and to be elected in any election of the society.
  - (b) To submit suggestion for discusion to the Governing Body and subcommittee on any matter.
  - (c)To se inspect the accounts of the society on appointment with the secretary.
  - (d) To forgo his membership after due information in writing to the Governing Body.

  - (e) To pay his subscription within the prescribed time.(f) Dafaulting members shall not be allowed to take part or vote

in meeting.
(a) Members shall have one vote each.

#### GOVERNING BODY.

not less then five and not more then 20 members and will be composof the Founder members and elected members. Elected members shall be
elected at the annual general meeting of the society. The Office bearers
of the Govarning Body shall consist of President, Vice-President, Secretary, Assistant Secretary and Treasurer. The officer Bearers shall
be elected by the Governing Body from amongest themselves.

- Trmination of membership :- A member of the Governing Body shall cease to be a member of the Governing Body if (a) he resigns by letter addressed to be the Secretary, (b) he absents himself form theree consecutive meetings of the Governing Body without any leave or without any reasonable ground, (c) he is convicted of any offence in connection with the formation, promotion, management of conduct of the affairs of the society, or of a body corporate, or of any offence involving moral trupitude.
- 3. Meeting: Ameeting of Governing Body shall be held at least once in three months at such place and time as the president or the secretary may determine. Any five members of the Governing body may requisition the meeting of the Governing Body and the Secretary shall summon the same within seven days and failing which the president or the requisition may do son provided on business other then specified in the notice shall be transacted at such meeting.
- 4. Notice: Seven days notice of the meeting specifying the place, time and the general nature of work and business to be transacted shall be given to every member of the Governing Body. Emergeney meeting may be called on 24 hours notice. Four members personally present shall constitute a quorufor the meeting and if a quorum is not present within 30 minutes of the time the members present may adjourn the meeting.
- Procedures of the meeting: The president or in his absence the VicePresident shall preside over all meeting of the Governing Body and in
  their absence members presedent shall elect a Chairman of the meeting.
  All questions before the meeting will be decided by a majority of votes
  each member having one vote. The president or the chairman shall have
  a second or casting vote in addition to he own vote int the case of
  equality of votes.
- 6. Powers and Duties of the Govening Body: The Governing Body shall have general power of supervision and conduct over all the affairs of the society and in particular shall discharge the following duties:—
  (i) To asummon the Annual General Meeting of the Society (ii) To appoint sub-comm ittee with such power and duties as may be considered necessary of expedient, (iii) To accept donation, gift, subscription moveable or immpvable property for the objects of the Society, (iv) To sell, lease, mortgage of otherwise dispose of the deal with all or any part of the property of the society, (v) To keep proper accounts of the society to open bank account in the name of the society in one or more of the banks, Bank accounts will be operated by the President jointly with the Secretary or Treasurer of the Society.

### :: SAFE CUSTODY OF FUNDS ::

- The Governing Body or the trustee of the society shall be responsible for the safe custody of the funds and assets of the society.
- The funds of the society shall be kept in the local Bank and be invested in any securities specified under section 20 of the Indian Trust Act .-1882.



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## BOOKS OF ACCOUNS & INSPECTION OF

books of accounts and other statutory books shall be kept at the equistered office and shall by open to inspection of the member of the Governing Body during usual office hours and the same shall be open to inspection of the members at such time and plase as the Governing Body directs on a written requst made by any members.

### :: ACCOUNTING YEAR ::

The accounting year of the society shall be English Calender year. :: GENERAL MEETINGS ::

There shall be own kinds of general meetings.

a) annual and b) special or extraordinary.

- The society shall hold an annual general meeting as last once in every year and not more then 15 months shall elapse between two successived annual general meetings. At least 14 days notice specifing the time; Plece, the day and hour shall be given to every member of the society.
- The quorum for transaction of any business, shall be one third of the total members in the register present either personnally or by proxy.
- 4. The business to be transacted at the annual general meeting

(a) To confirm the munutes of the last annual general meeting and if any.

(b) To adopt with or without modification the report of the working of the society for the previous year ended.

(c) To pass audited accounts for the said year.
(d) To appoint qualified auditor or auditors.

(e) To elect president and other office bearers of the Governing Body.

5. A special general meeting shall be convened by the Secretary if twothirds members of the society requisitioned such meeting specifying the nature of the business to be transacted the meeting on receint of the secretary shall hold such meeting with 21 days. In default by the secretary, the requistionists shall hold such meeting, provided no business other then that specified in the notice shall be

### SUITS & LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

All suits and legal proceedings by or aiginst the society shall be in the name of the secretary or by such person as shall be appointed by the committee for the occasion.

### ALTERATION OF RULES & REGULATIONS

The Governing Body shall have powers to make such Byelaws and Rules and regulation as may be considered necessary in the interest of the society. These Rules and Regulation may be altered, modified, rescinded or added to by special resolution passed by the members in general meeting valied by the purpose by three- fourths mojority of the members president at such meetting.

### DISSOLUTION OF THE SOCIETY

The society may be dissolved by a resolution to that effect passed by three- fourths of the members of the society present at a general meeting. The said meeting shall also decide the manner of disbursement of the funds and assets of the association, if any, after dissolution.
